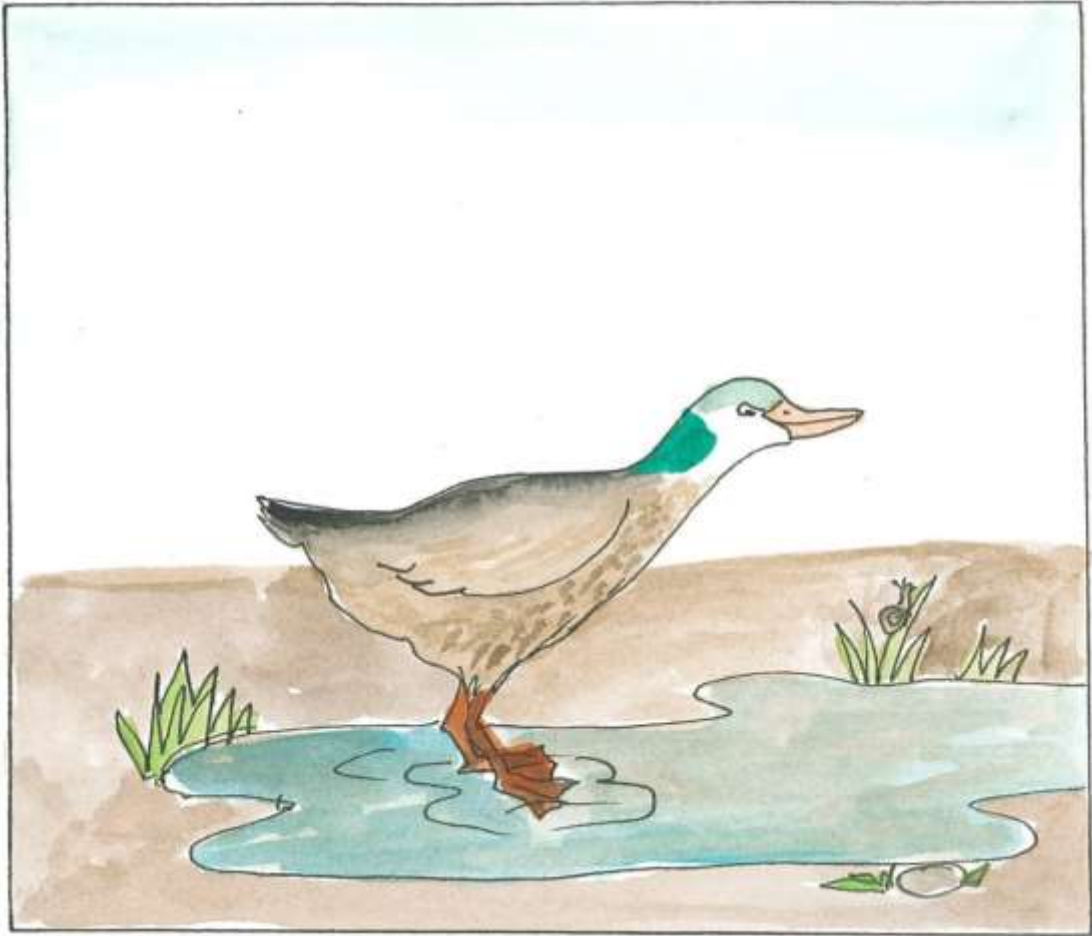
Is mait liom an muc.

I like the pig.



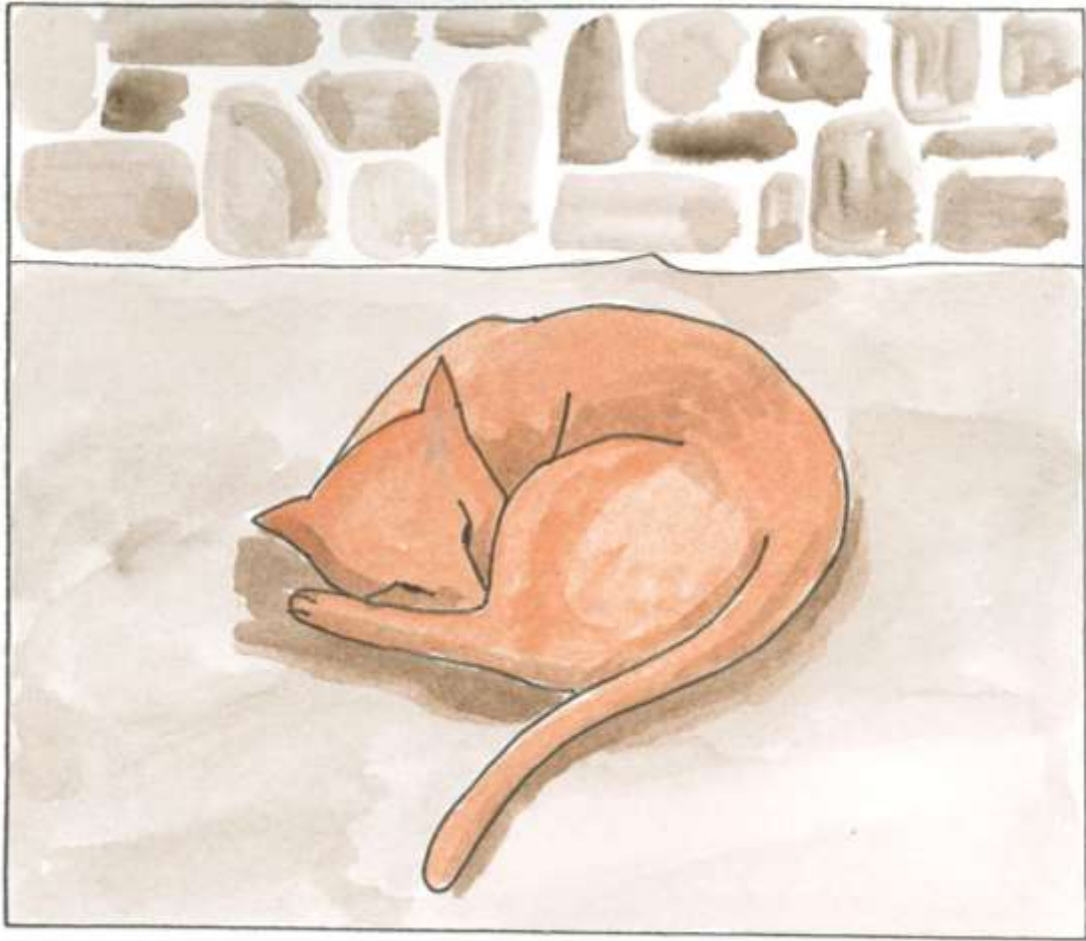
Is mait liom an cearc.
