## **Summary**

As a condition of employment, all tutors new to the Faculty of Arts are required to complete 'Arts Foundations', a set of professional development (PD) modules created and convened by teaching experts from the Arts Teaching Innovation (ATI) team.

Arts Foundations modules are completed online via the University's Learning Management System (LMS), Canvas.

On completion of the modules, you will be paid in accordance with the Faculty's <u>Local Operating Rule</u>.

### What is Arts Foundations?

These training, induction and PD modules provide:

- Theoretical bases for the Faculty's preferred approaches to teaching
- A repertoire of classroom activities that are inclusive and engaging
- Information about your role, responsibilities, and key contacts
- Lists of further key services and resources to support you in your role

## How do I access and complete Arts Foundations?

Access <u>Canvas</u> using your staff username, supplied to you after you have accepted your Letter of Engagement. Arts Foundations will appear in your list of Canvas enrolments within 1-2 business days of receiving your staff username. It is your responsibility to access and complete the modules after this time.

Completion is expected prior to the commencement of classes. Sessional staff appointed after classes have begun are expected to complete within two weeks of

commencement. Arts Foundations will cease to be available after Friday April 19 – 8 weeks into Semester 1.

You are advised to work through the modules in blocks of at least two consecutive hours. If you work for a five-hour block or greater, be sure to take a 30-minute break (unpaid). On completion, you will be instructed on claiming payment for training through your timecard, to an estimated total of eight hours at the Other Casual Academic Activity, Level A.2 rate.
