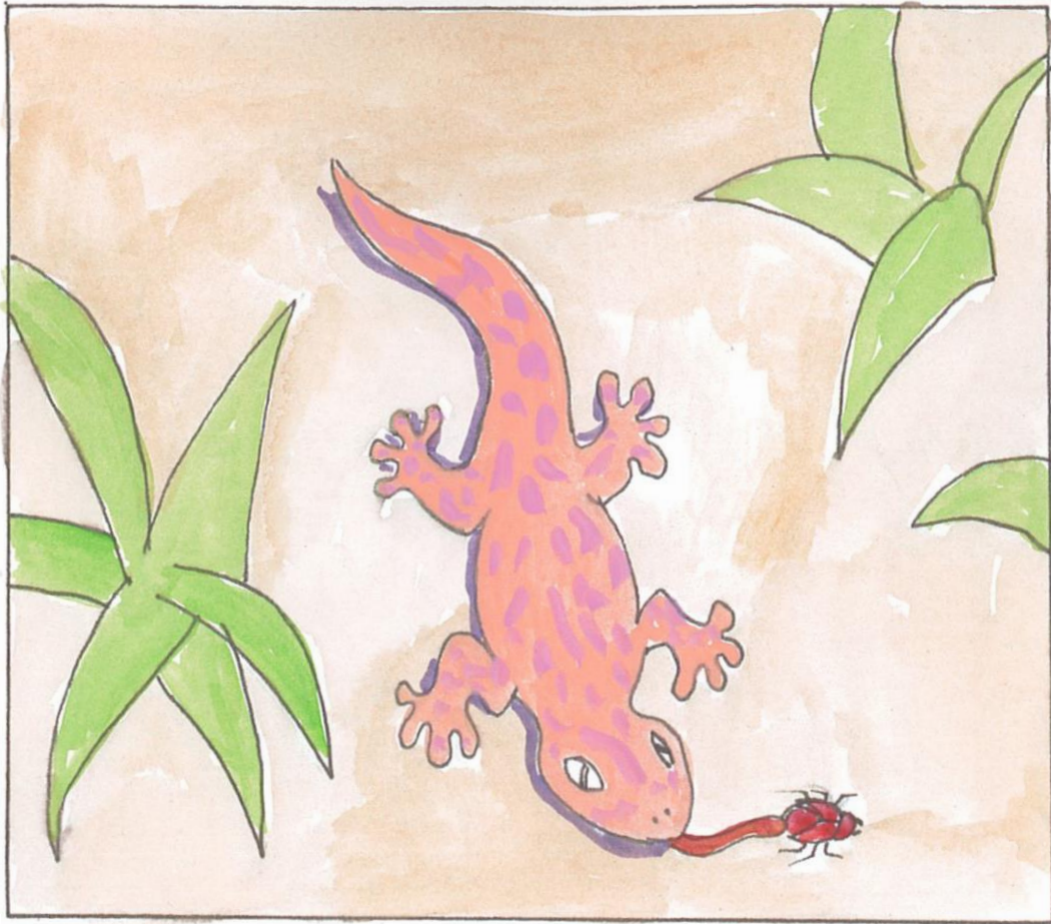

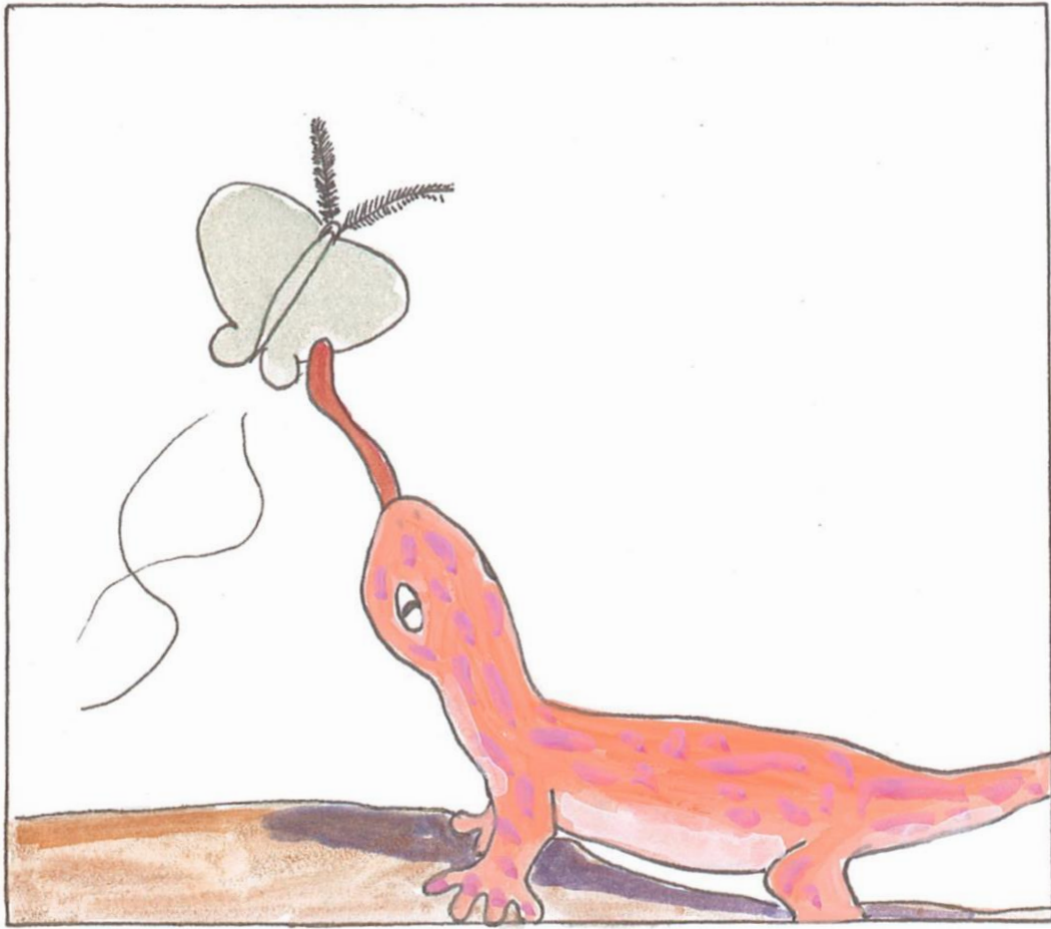

he kacak thai” ati.



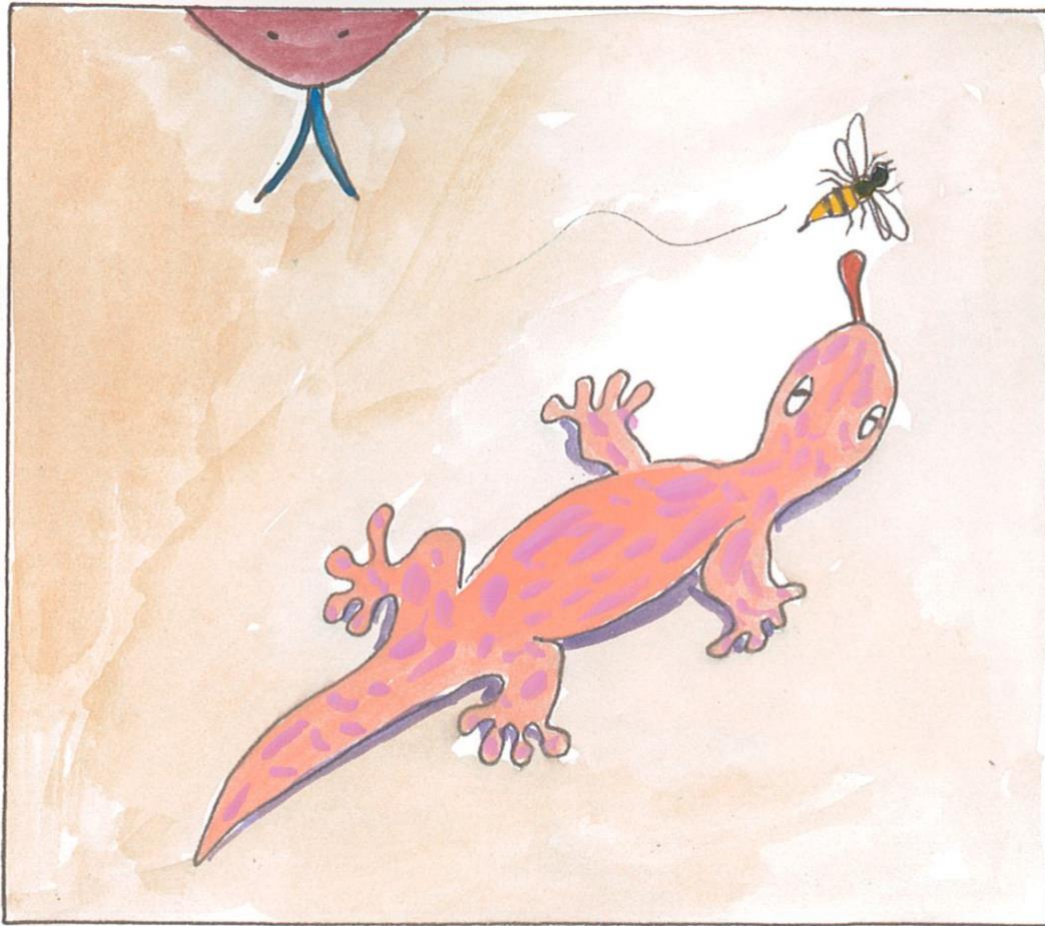
Tawkke loh “hikah aekmuet

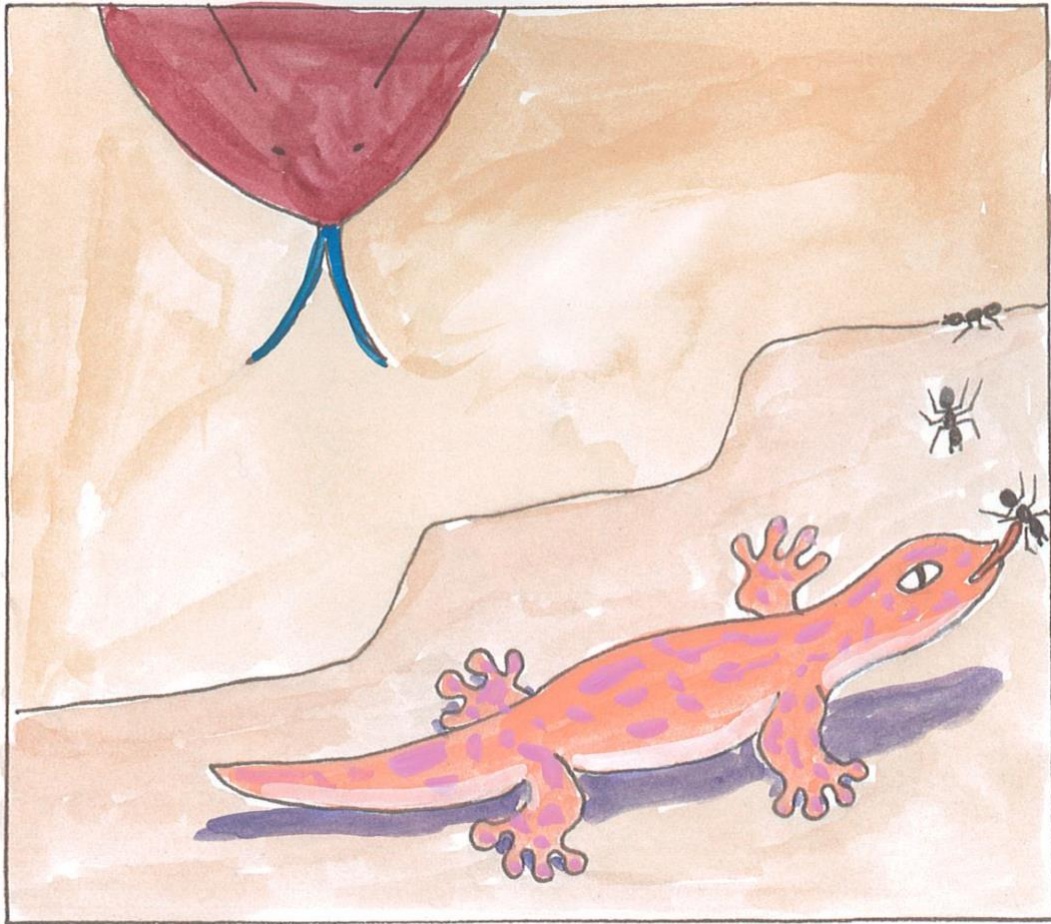


Tawkke loh “hikah rhaisih

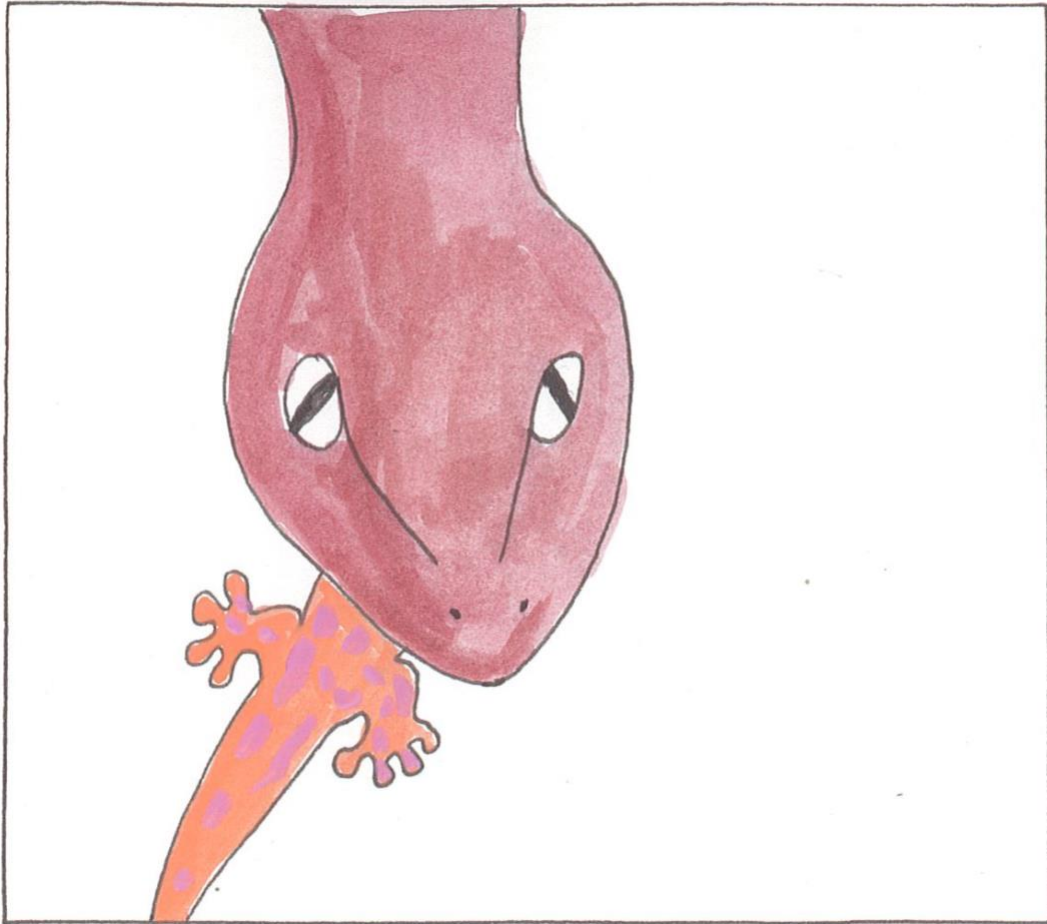
