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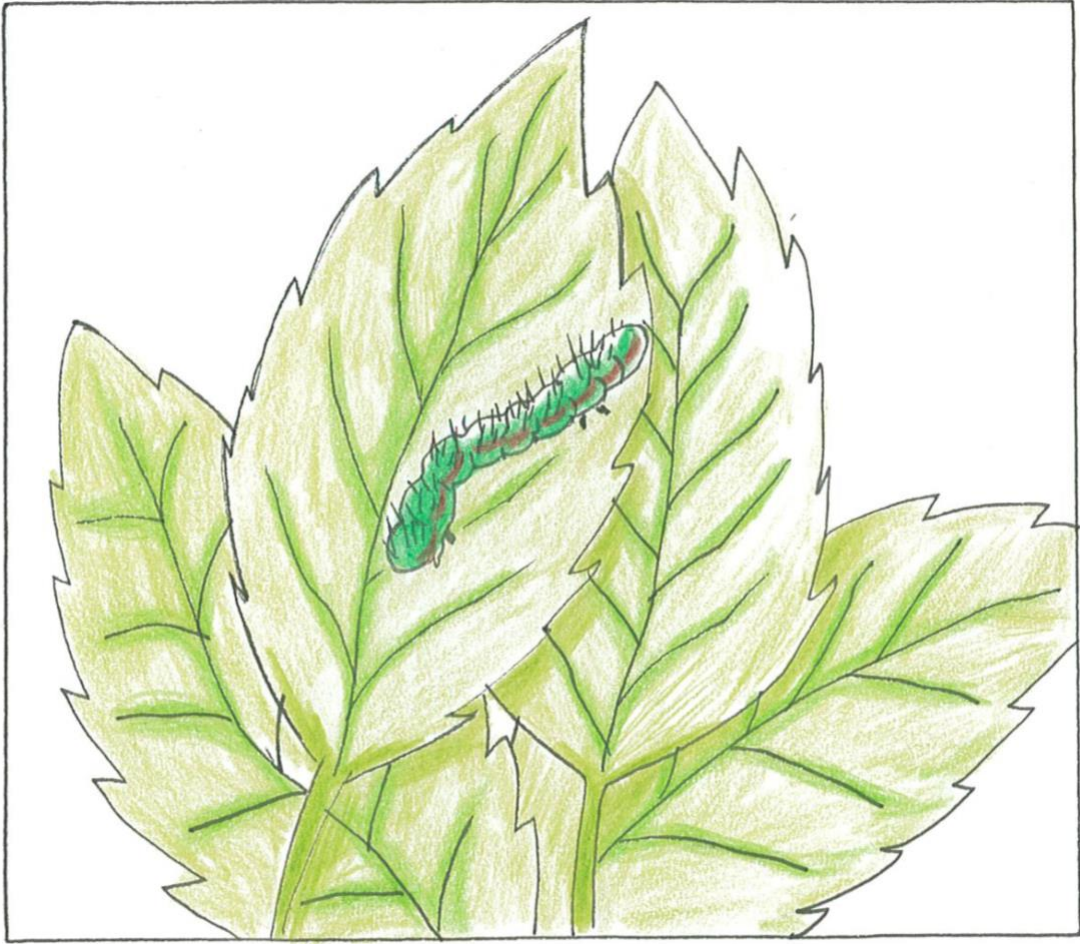
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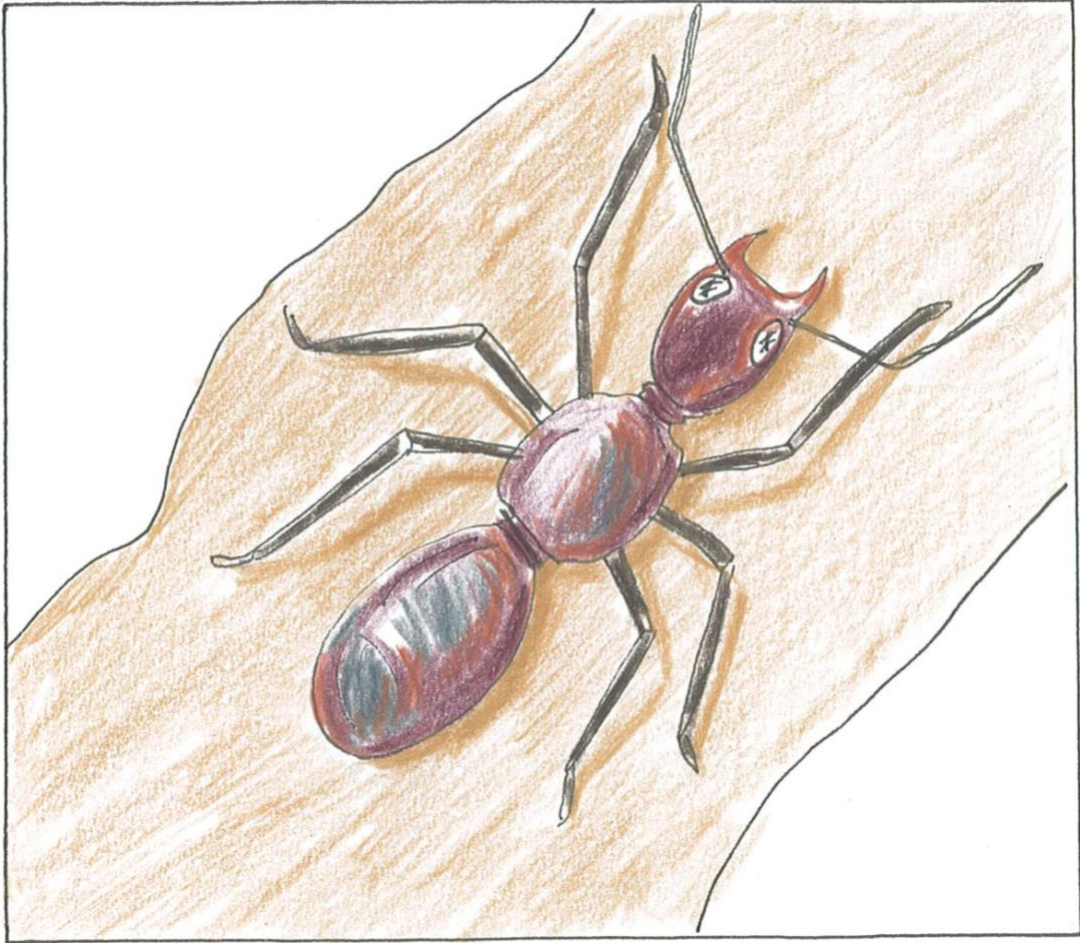
Khoi loh “Kading thai”

says the ant.



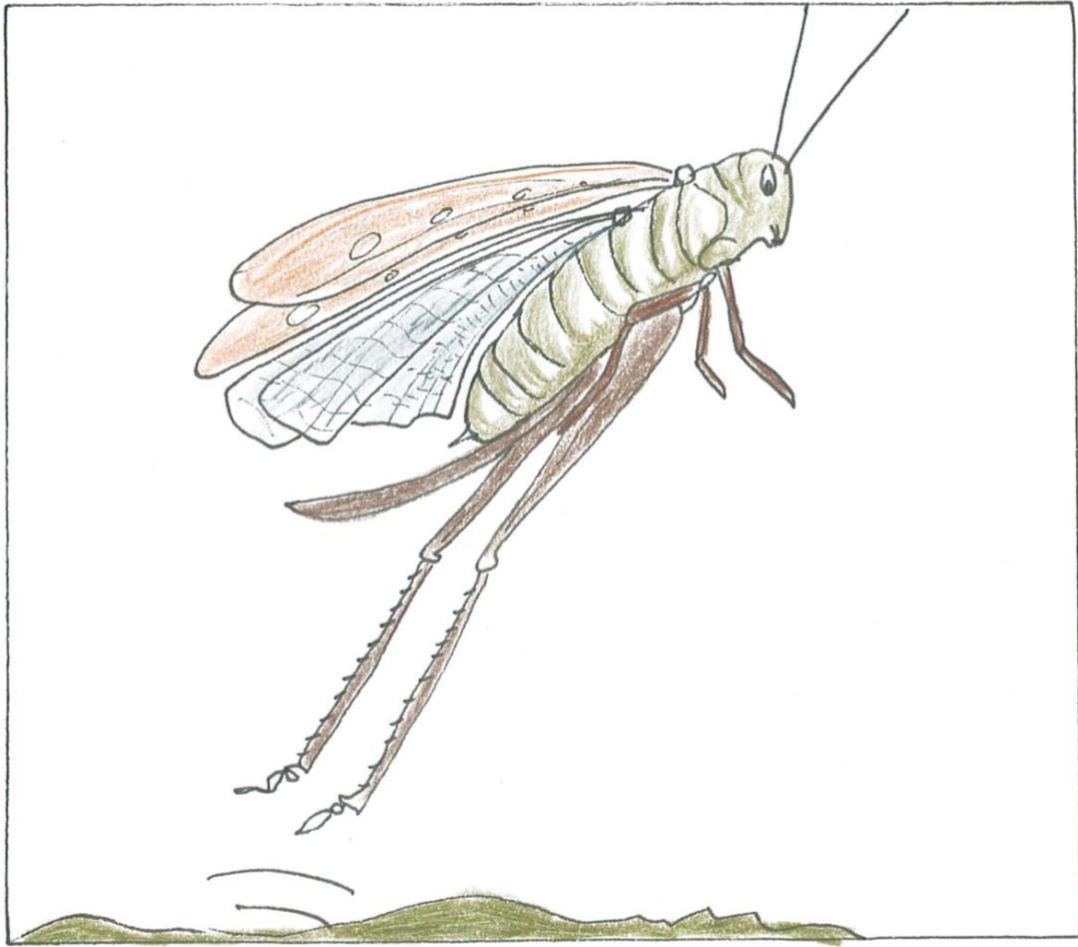
Rhaisihtangboeng loh

says the insect.



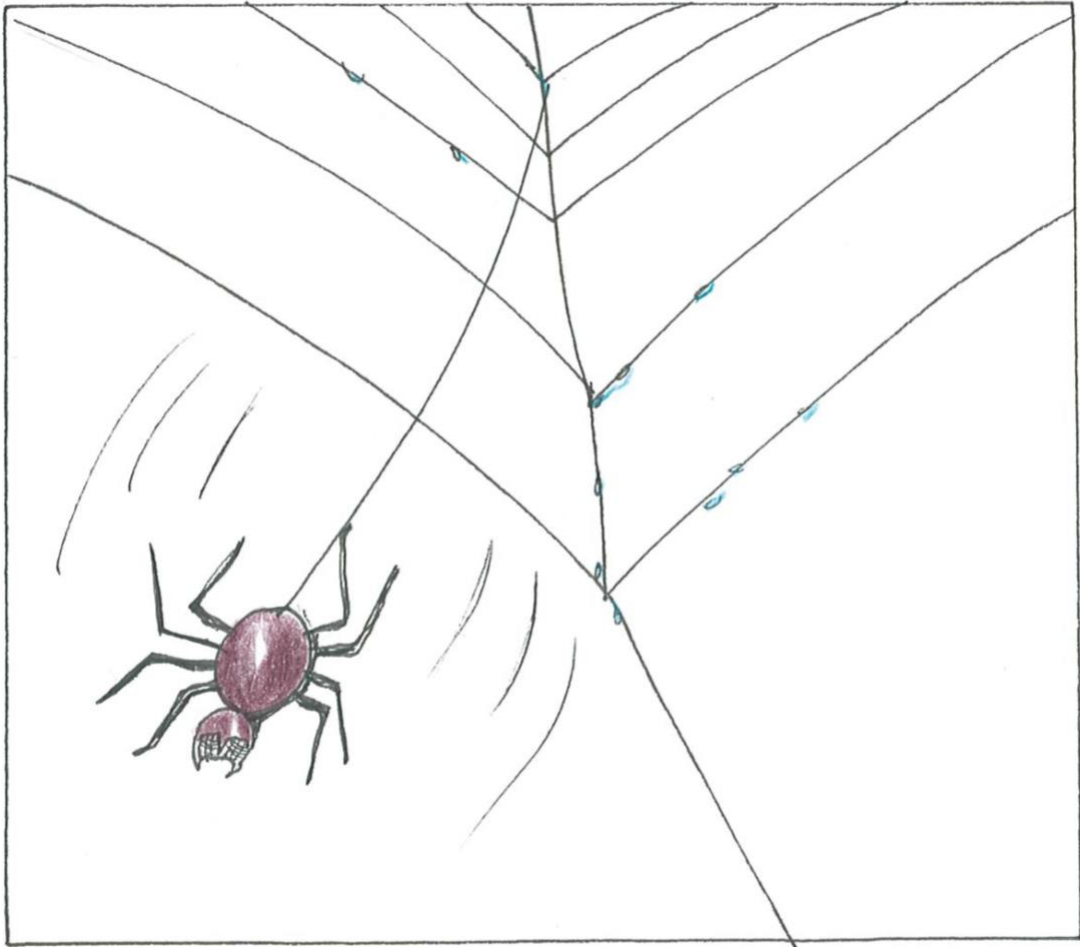
Nga loh “Tuikayaa thai”
