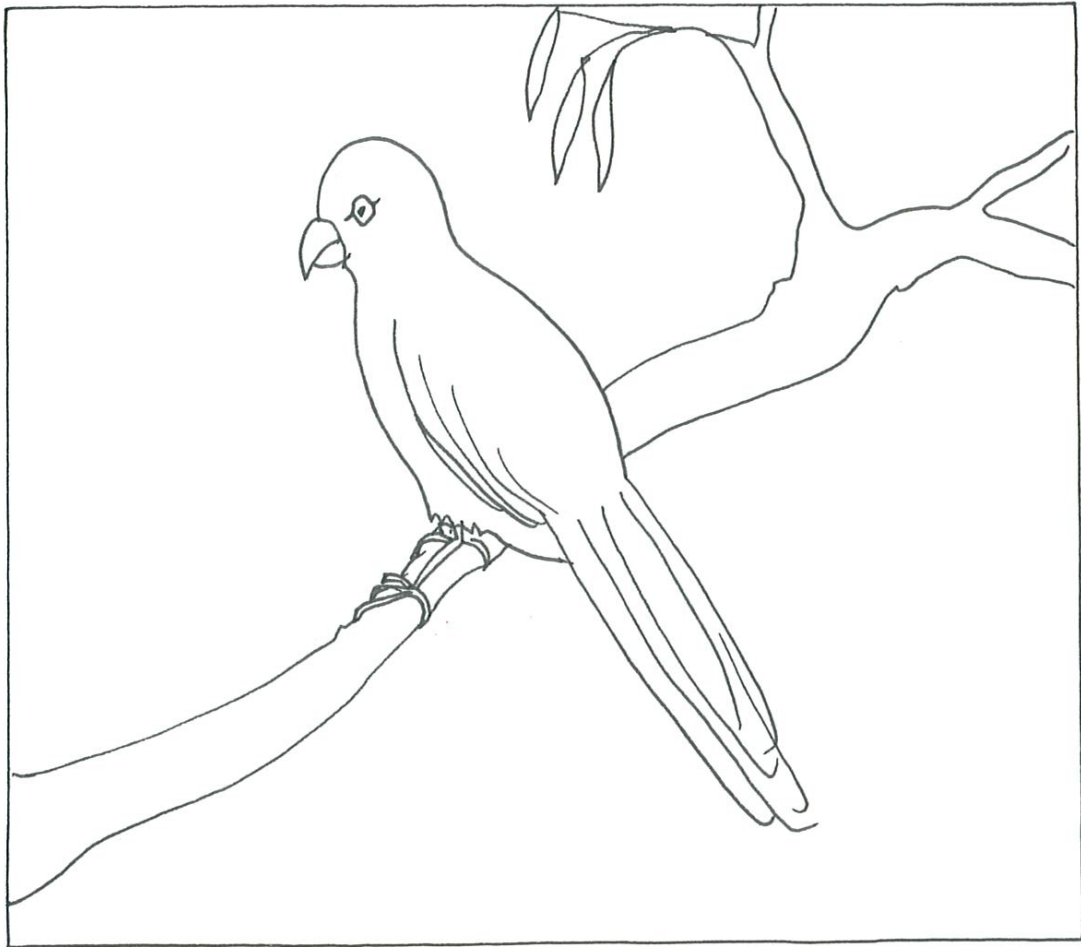

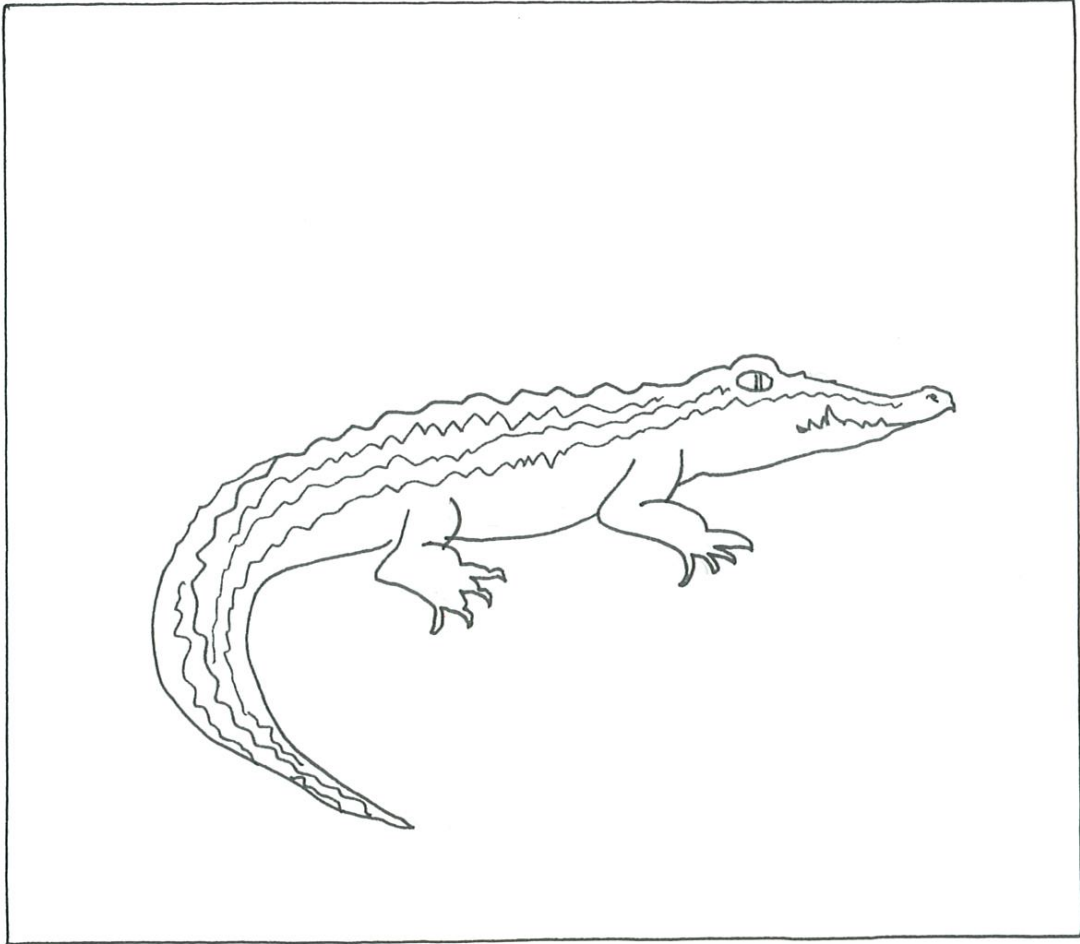

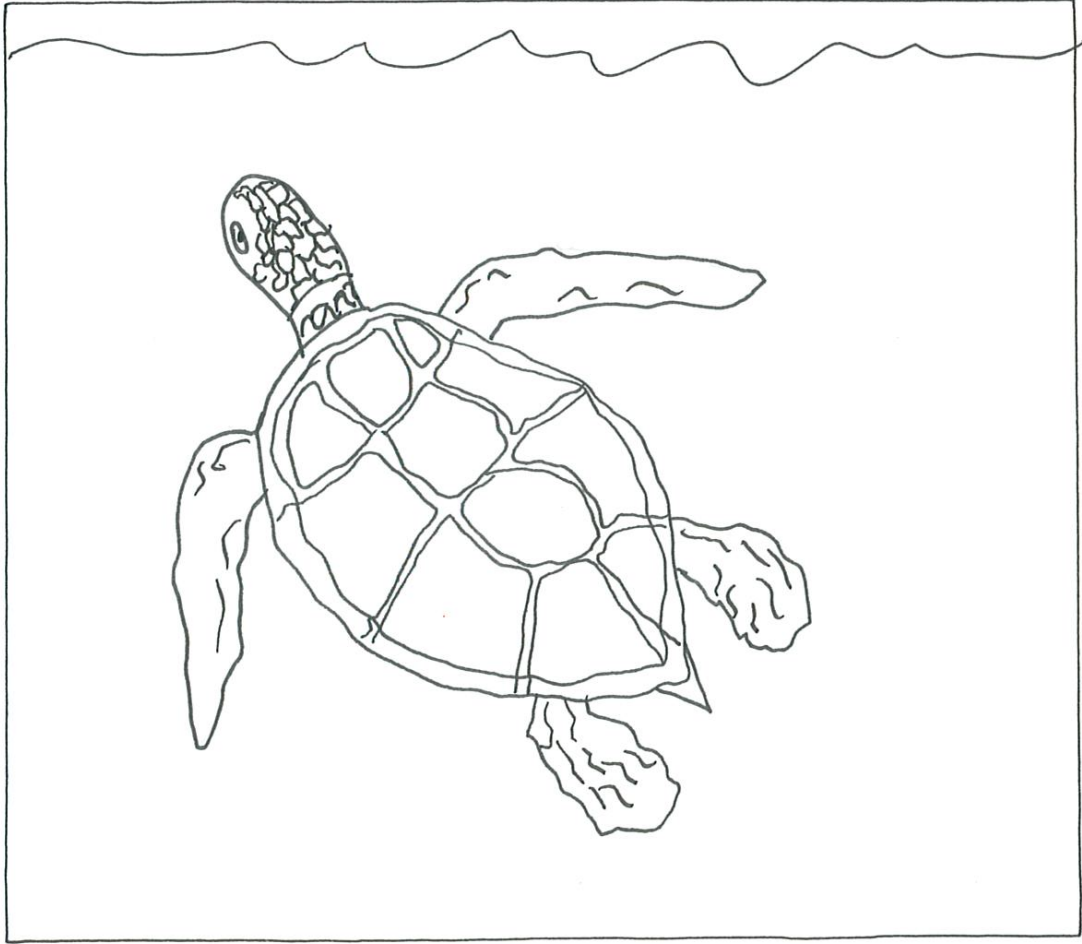

a long tail.



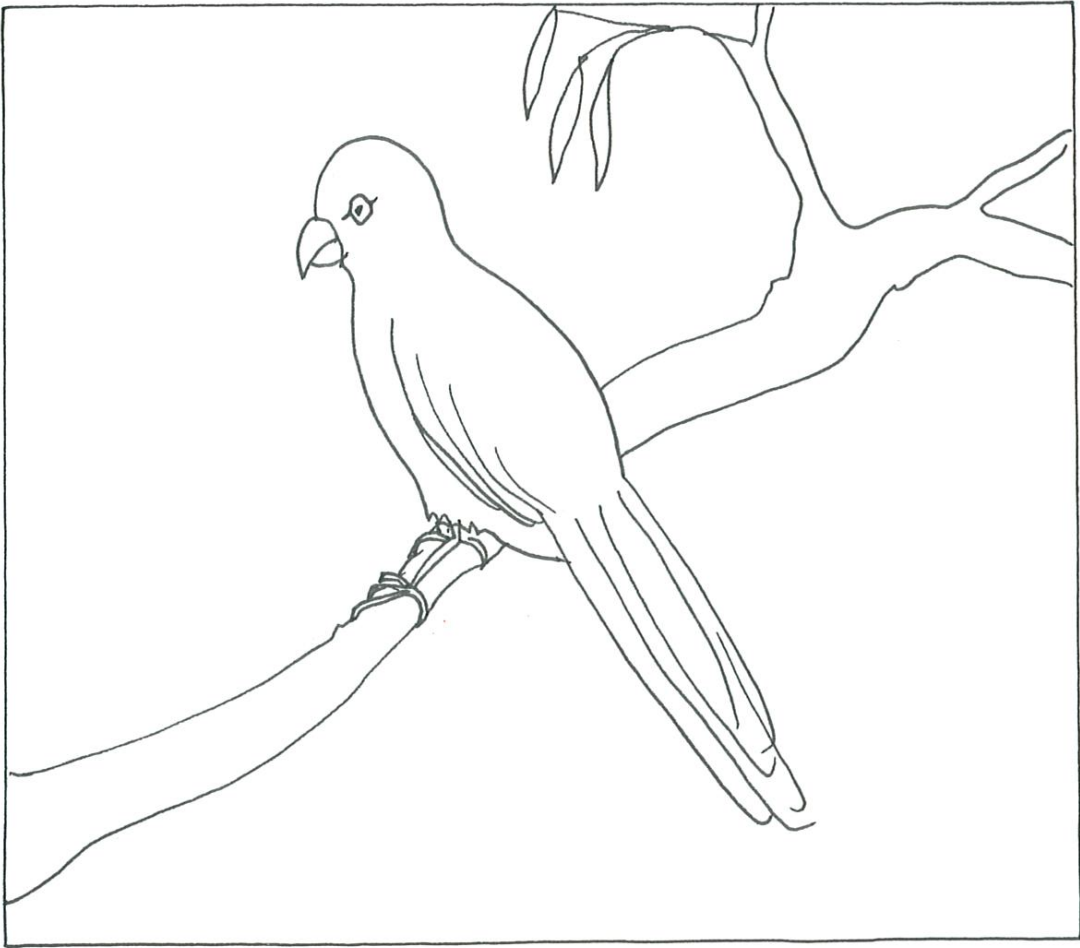

a bumpy tail.



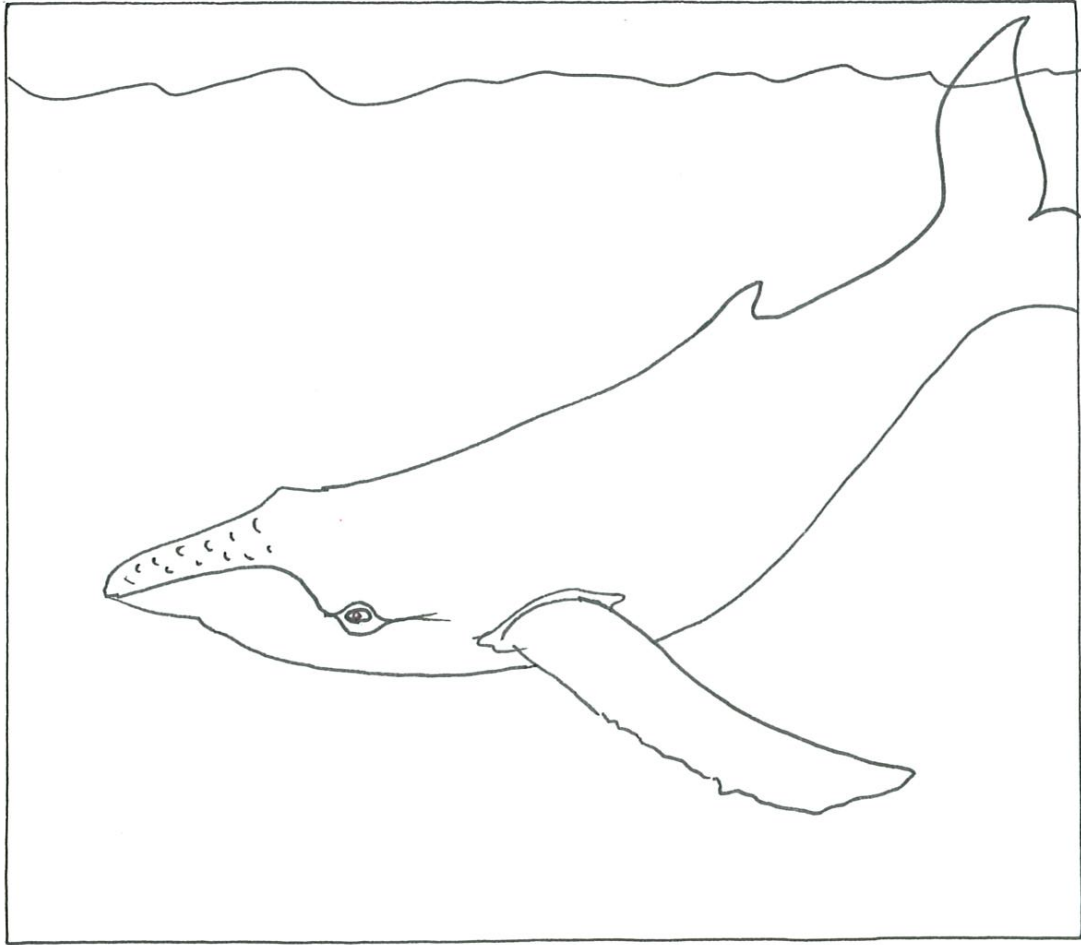
Qubo-diin waxay qabtaa

a short tail.



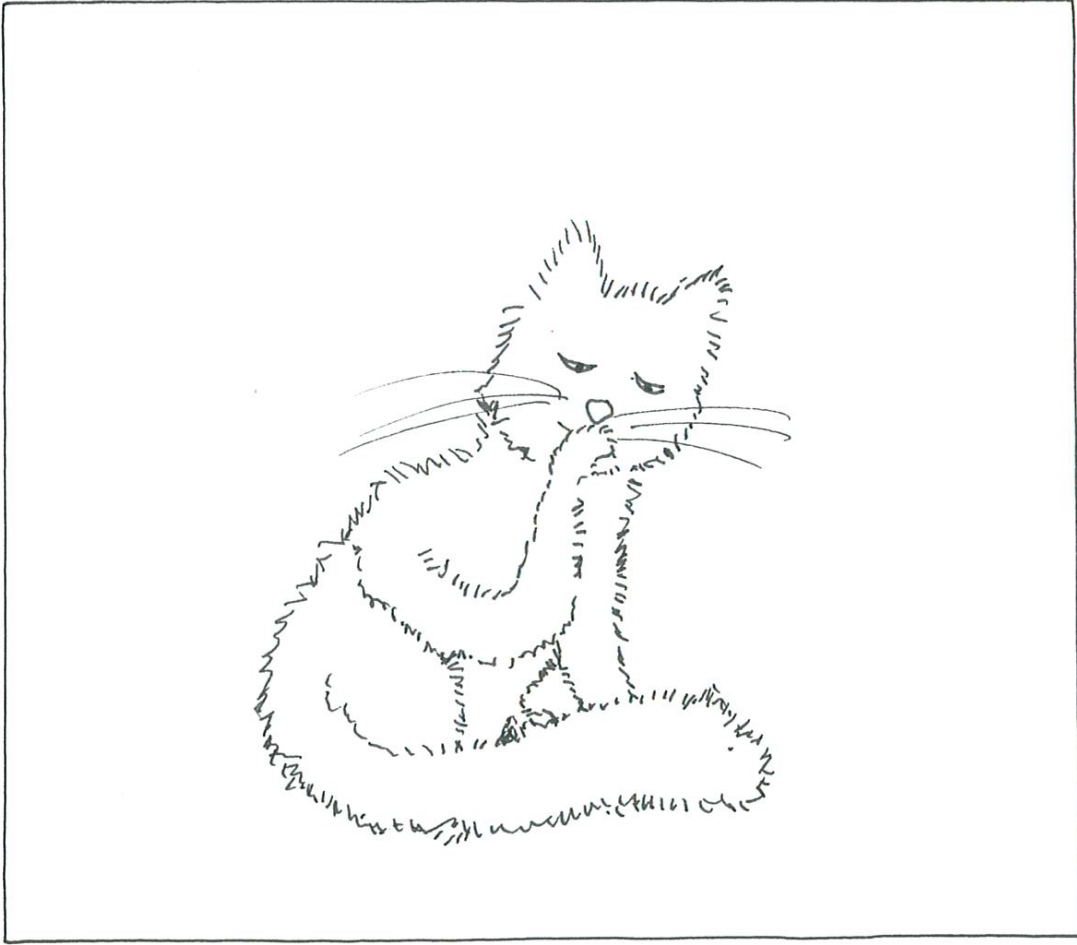
Shimbir waxay qabtaa

a straight tail.



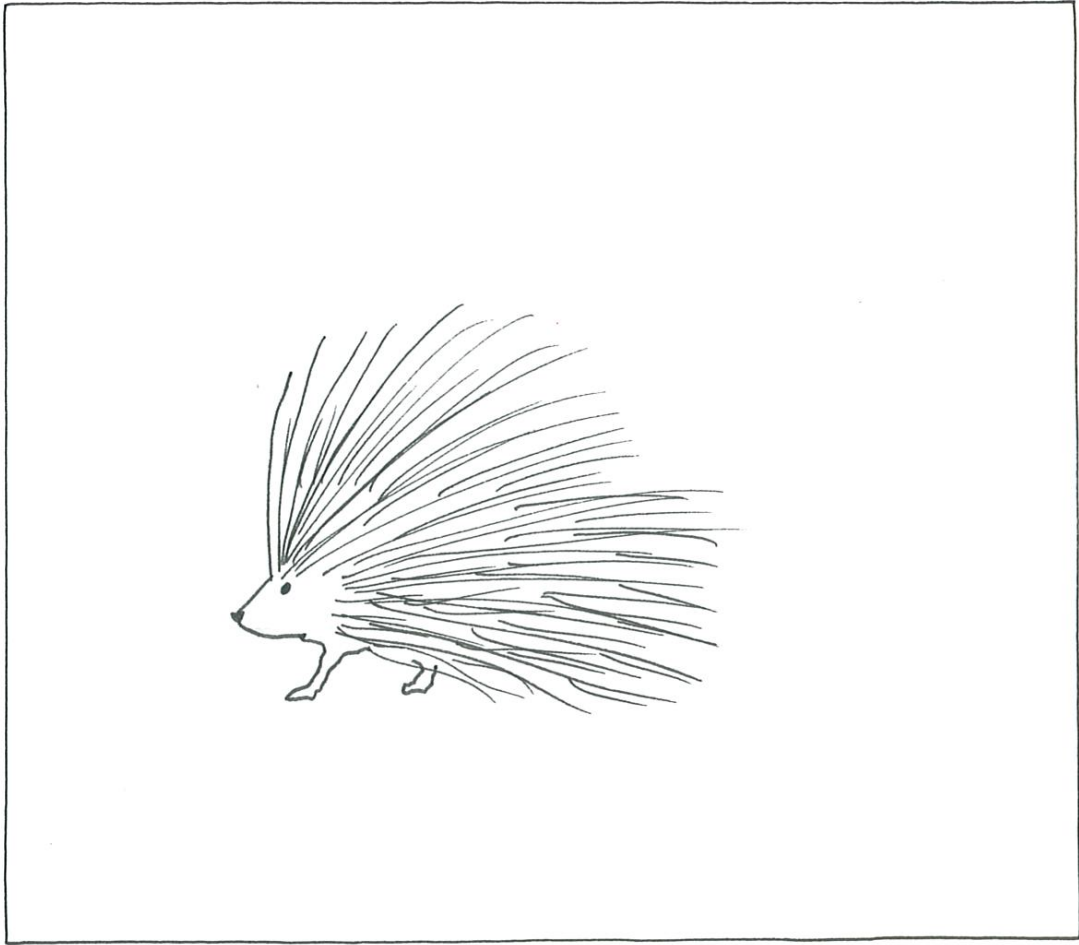
Nibiri wuxuu qabaa
