# Strengthening the Role of the IAEA

## Recommendation #1

- A Strategic Plan for the Nuclear Security Division, taking into account:
  - end of NSS process
  - entry into force of CPPNM Amendment
  - areas where Agency can add value to other efforts and improve collaboration with ICSANT, SCR 1540, GCINT
  - US should move to make payments on time
  - future possible threats, not just past/current

# **Strengthening the Role of the IAEA**

## **Recommendation #2**

Adequate funding for nuclear security work:

- more funding not tied to specific projects
- internal collaboration with other parts of Agency (safety, safeguards)
- closer collaboration with other IOs
- a grand budgetary bargain?

# Strengthening the Role of the IAEA

## Recommendation #4

The post-summit Contact Group should be encouraged to prepare a 'prospectus' on nuclear security and assist in securing additional resources for the Agency.

# Strengthening the Role of the IAEA

## Recommendation #5

Improve transparency, information-sharing, confidence-building:

- IAEA should better communicate nuclear security message, including to developing countries
- IAEA should encourage information sharing on member states' commitments/implementation, esp. after CPPNM Amendment is in force
- Capitalize on CoEs

# Strengthening the IAEA

## Miscellaneous Recommendations

More specific ideas:

- Study ICAO experience with standards and funding
- Move to make guidelines the equivalent of safety standards and beyond
- Establish a nuclear sabotage reporting system
- Collaborate with industry on security for new facilities
