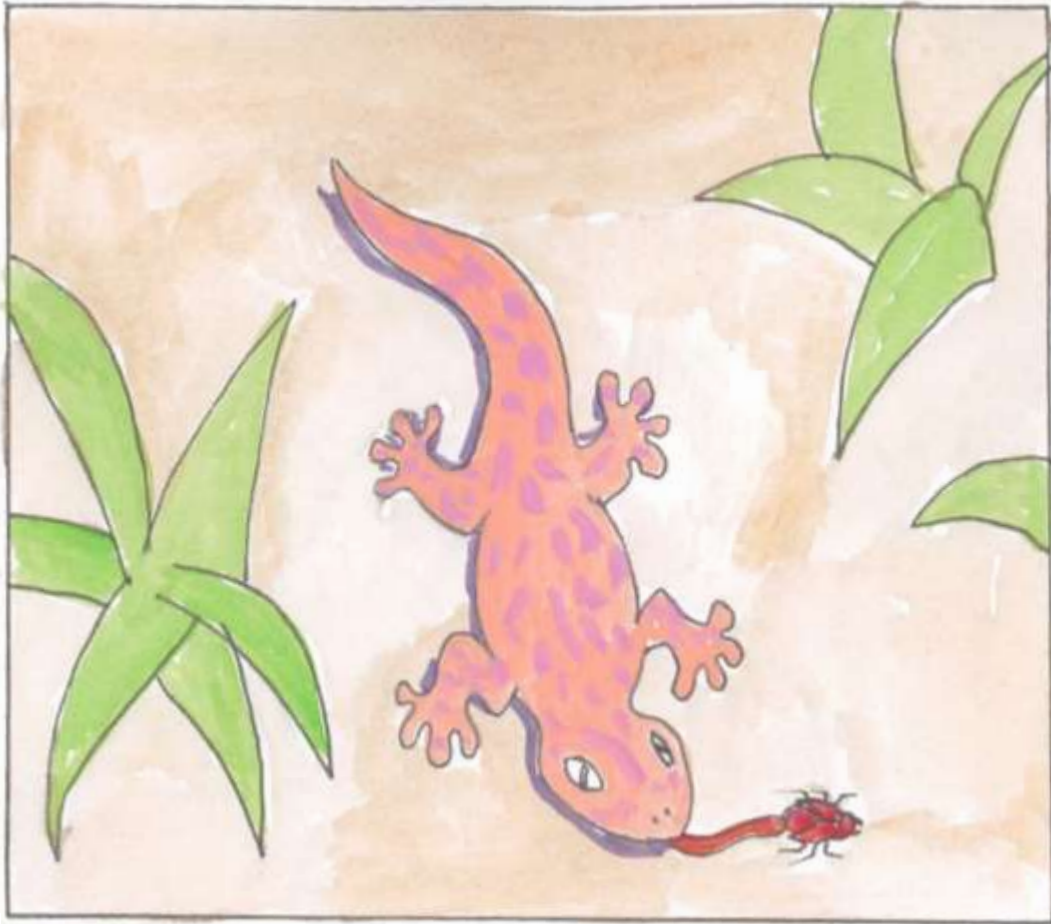

said Gecko.



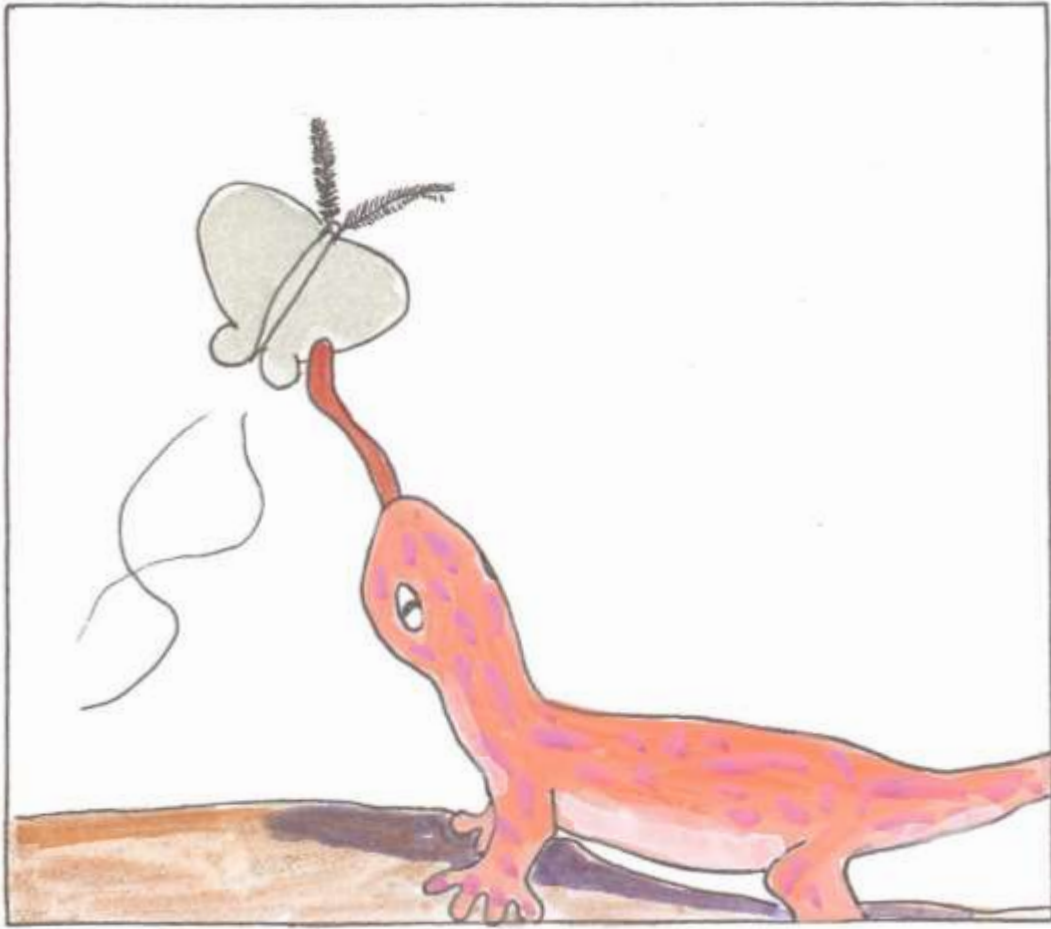

said Gecko.



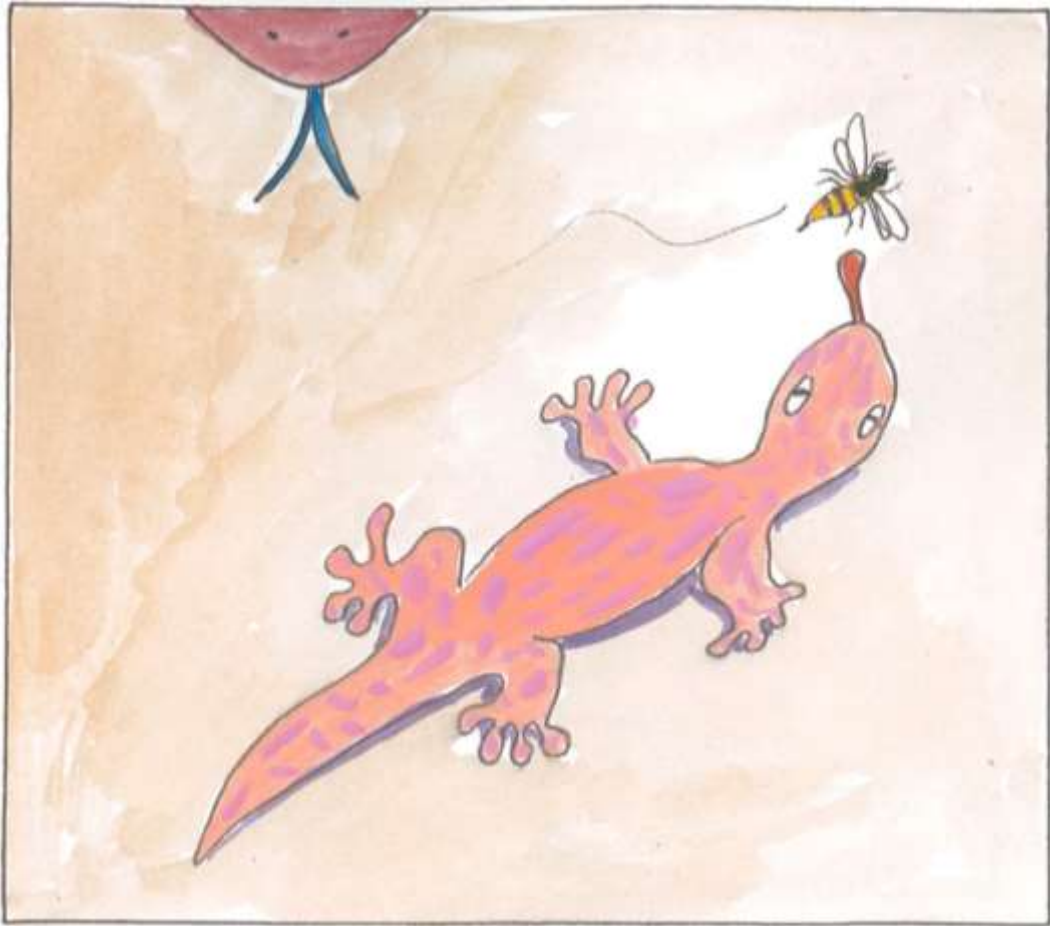

said Gecko.



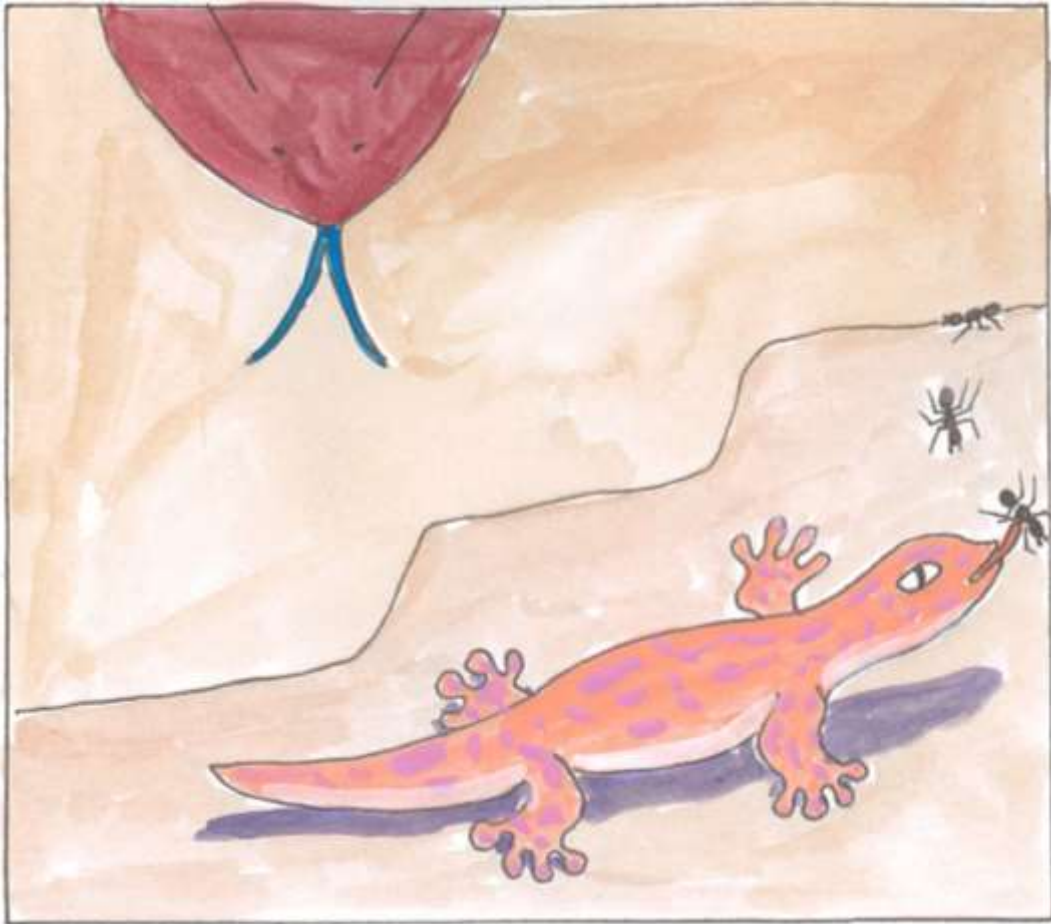
«Μπορώ να φάω αυτή

said Gecko.



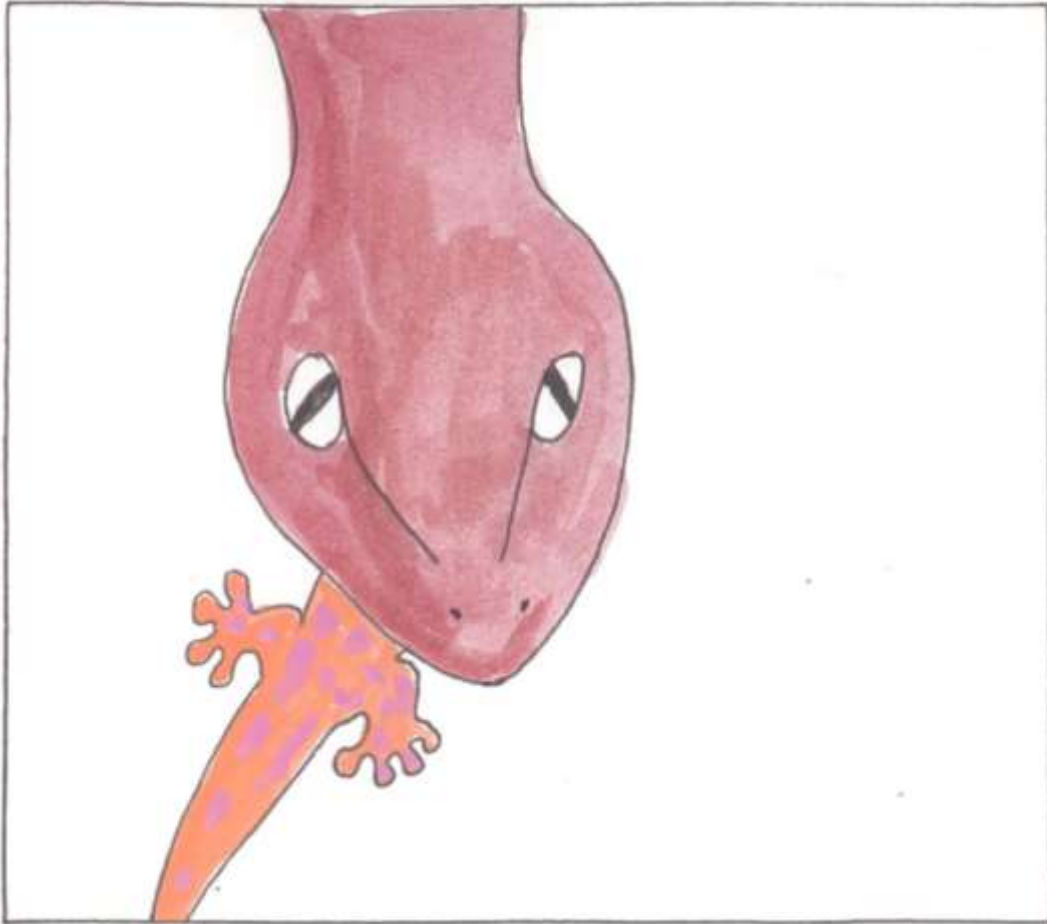
